

## Scott Disick 'not same person' after 'drawn in' weight loss amid Ozempic speculation

EXCLUSIVE: Scott Disick sparked fan concern when he stepped out in Los Angeles looking notably thinner and now Dr. Levine has weighed in on the speculation.

## Scott Disick's latest transformation wasn't received well by fans.

The 40-year-old TV personality was spotted stepping out in Los Angeles earlier this week after enjoying a night out with some pals.

While Scott, who frequently appeared on Keeping Up with the Kardashians, was wearing baggy clothes, it was clear he had dropped some pounds off of his waistline as well as his face.

Fans pointed out how his eyes were "sunken in" the fact he "looks like a walking skeleton now," following his drastic weight loss.

Along with fans pointing out Scott's notable weight loss, others began speculating what had caused it - and Ozempic was a common theme among many of the comments.

And now, **Dr. Elie Levine MD**, a leading cosmetic surgeon based in New York, has exclusively told TheExpress.com what he thinks of Scott's new look and whether he thinks the infamous weight-loss drug has anything to do with it.

"It clearly appears that Scott Disick has lost a considerable amount of weight. Weight loss can come from any number of sources, including Ozempic, diet, exercise, or addictions. there is also a fine line between being thin, and possibly being too thin and appearing too thin," **Dr.** Levine explained.

"His face clearly looks drawn and it has an aging effect. One must consider in Scott's case, that he is 40 years old," he also went on to point out, suggesting his age could be a factor contributing to his transformation.

"I have found over the years that most people between the ages of 35 and 40 no longer are the same person that they were when they were 20 years old. One can lose weight, even a lot of weight in their 20's and 30's and continue to look great. However, once one reaches their mid-thirties to 40s, losing too much weight in a short period of time can age one's appearance," the surgeon added.

Scott has yet to address or explain why he has dropped so many pounds to the point where fans are concerned for his well-being.

During an episode of The Kardashians, Scott opened up about gaining weight after he suffered an injury to his back when he was involved in a near-fatal car crash in 2022 - and many think he resulted to Ozempic to get the unwanted weight back off.

Ozempic is a diabetes medicine used with diet and exercise to treat adults whose type 2 diabetes is not satisfactorily controlled. The treatment can also cause users to lose around 1kg or around 1.1% of body weight after one month.
